NCW 2020 : The theme of this second international conference in Galway is addressed to the current practice and recent developments in understanding the role of wetlands in catchment management, in pollution control, in climate change and in hydro-ecological functioning. A workshop on the problems of infrastructure and the impact on wetlands is included.
